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TYPES OF TRAMWAYS

TOURIST TRAM

- Equipped with Trolley or Pantograph
- Low Speeds (Max. 30 km/h)
- Adapted Old Vehicles
- Layout with Many Curves
- In General Not Compensated Lines

URBAN TRAMWAY

- Equipped with Pantograph
- Average Speeds (Max. 60 km/h)
- In General Compensated Lines
- Cross Curves and Rounds without Brackets
- Distance Between Stops ≤ 500 m



LIGHT METRO

- Equipped with Pantograph
- High Speeds (Max. 80 km/h)
- Completely Compensated Lines
- Larger Radius Curves
- Always Suspension with Poles
- Distance Between Stops ≥ 500 m




MECHANICAL FEATURES OF INSULATING BRACKETS



TYPICAL MOUNTS OF TRAMWAY CATENARY (Flexible Catenary)




SIDE POST CURVE SIMPLE WAY





POLE IN RALLWAY GAUGE TWO BRACKETS


















CONTACT WIRE SUSPENSION FOR: TUNNELS, BRIDGES, STATIONS, DEPOTS AND WORKSHOPS

COMPONENTS



RIGID BAR

It consists of a extruded aluminum bar, lengths of 10 or 12 m with a characteristics section, used for the conduction of the current feeding of units subway and railway.

BAR RAMP

Bar of extruded aluminum in lengths of 4, 6, 10 or 12 m with a slight curvatures along 1,5 m in order to smooth the entry of the pantograph under overlaps and transitions. Alloy 6106 TS.





CONNECTION PLATES

These plates serve as connections between the profiles. They are adapted to the internal form of the bar and give a exact transition and continuity.

DOUBLE ELECTRIC POWER FEED

Unit consisting of two aluminum flanges that are attached to the PAC profile using 2 stainless steel threaded rods. The flanges will have two holes, each of them allowing to fix the power wire terminals or jumper wire.



EARTHING CLAMP WITH STIRRUP

To do the maintenance work, install a plate of the same material with a stirrup which is suspended by the earthing bar.



FIX POINT ASSEMBLY

To direct the expansion process and prevent displacement of rigid catenary, a fix point is located in the middle of each section. We must control the forces due to the expansion of the profile and others caused by the friction of the pantograph.

WEAK FIXED POINT

Unit consisting of two aluminium flanges that are attached to the PAC-110 or PAC 80R profile through two threaded roaf. Is dispossed a flange on each side of the hanger clamp, blocking the movement at that point. System used in short lenghts as diagonals double crossovers



EXPANSION JOINT

This element can absorb the length variations because of the temperature changes experienced in the catenary sectioning. It can absorb expansion up to 1m in length. No maintenance is required. Rated Voltage. - 25kV



SECTION INSULATOR

Set formed by profiles, skates and insulators used to maintain two contiguous sections of rigid catenary isolate, in railroad and subway.

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
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
